Characteristics of this format

Meet your peers on site, match with your team, and take on a challenge together. Be prepared for time management, intensive communication, quick decision-making, and creativity sprints. Collaborate with entrepreneurs, mentors, and experts to generate ideas and prototypes in answer to the challenges.

Mobility & locations

The first part of this I Living Lab format takes place online from 06 November to 24 November 2023. Subsequently, you will travel to Austria for a week from 27 November to 01 December 2023 in order to work on your chosen topic with your teammates.

Team composition

The teams are built according to your talents and personal preferences. The aim is to achieve the best possible match of different students and their vocational skills and business talents.

Schedule

The Intensive I Living Lab will start out online over a period of three weeks. During this period, you are introduced to the design thinking method, you get to know your team and start working on your topic. For the on-site week, you travel to Austria for working together with your team.
